There can be underlying, serious causes of dog nosebleeds: Nasal adenocarcinoma, or nose tumors, can cause excessive bleeding through one or both nostrils. Blood can expel from the nose when there is an internal injury in another part of the body that is not evident. A canine can have von Willebrand disease or hemophilia.

What Are the Causes of Nosebleeds in Dogs? - Pets

The most common cause of an acute nose bleed in a dog will be either trauma or an infection in their upper respiratory tract. If your dog is accident prone or he has a lot of inflammation in his nasal passages from a chronic infection you may see some bleeding from (usually) one nostril.

What to Do if Your Dog Has a Nose Bleed

Your dog may bleed from its nose for the following reasons (excluding superficial injuries such as a scratch): A violent shock or head trauma. Following a hit or blow to the head, your pet may suffer a concussion which could lead to internal bleeding. A nosebleed is the only visible symptom of this type of trauma.

Dogs who have snuffed up a foreign object into the nose usually sneeze violently, paw at the nose, and sometimes have a thick or bloody nasal discharge.
